TRANSGENDER WOMEN & HIV

- + At least 1 in 20 transgender women are living with HIV
- Black transgender women are at least 3x more likely to be diagnosed with HIV
- Latinx transgender women are at least 1.5x more likely to be diagnosed with HIV

BLACK PEOPLE & HIV

- Black people are 7x more likely than white people to be living with HIV
- 46% of people living with HIV in the U.S. are Black

YOUTH

 1 in 5 new HIV diagnoses are young people between 13 and 24 years old

ADDITIONAL FACTS

- + 9 out of 10 new infections are from sexual contact
- + 80% of new infections in men are from sex with other men
- + 7% of new infections resulted from injection drug use
- + HIV can only be transmitted through bodily fluids like semen and blood



SAFE SEX TIPS

TAKING PRECAUTIONS AGAINST HIV DOESN'T MEAN YOU SHOULD BE ASHAMED OF YOUR SEXUALITY — YOU CAN LOVE YOUR BODY *AND* STAY SAFE.

- ◆ You're at least 10x less likely to get HIV if you use a condom correctly
- If you don't have HIV but are sexually active, taking PrEP every day reduces your risk by a LOT - 74% from injecting drugs and 99% from sex
- If you are living with HIV, taking antiretroviral therapy (ART) and have an undetectable viral load, you are unable to transmit HIV to your partner; Undetectable = Untransmittable
